This picture shows a crowd of people in the “scramble” crossing in Shibuya, one of the busiest crossings in Tokyo. The building in the center is SHIBUYA TSUTAYA book store. A “scramble” crossing means a crossing where vehicles from all four directions are stopped and allows pedestrians to cross in every direction. It is so named because it has some analogy to scrambled eggs.

*pedestrian(s)= someone walking in the street and not traveling in a vehicle

*vehicle= something that is used for transporting people or goods from one place to another

Q1: Describe what's called “Scramble Crossing” in English.

→ It is a crossing where vehicles from all directions are stopped at a time for pedestrians.

Q2: Do you think this kind of crossing is convenient or dangerous? Why?

→ I think it is convenient / **dangerous**.

This is because there are so many people crossing the street at a time that they may hit another person.
