For the new ¥5,000, (3) was chosen. (4) She was one of the first ladies that went abroad to study. She went to America when she was only six years old. After she came back, she built a university to help many women to receive good *education and worked hard for women's rights.

Kitazato Shibasaburo is on the new \$1,000. He was a famous and important scientist. He worked hard to make *vaccines for *diseases. His work helped to save many lives and improve people's health both in Japan and around the world. \boxed{E}
